Competition Introduction

Asian Elite Dance Competition

Asian Elite Dance Competition, established in 2012, aims to promote the international vision of ballet arts education and the nurturing of young talents. AEDC aspires to build an artistic exchange platform for all the next generation artists from all over the world. Moreover, the competition is also dedicated to providing scholarship and interview opportunities from world renowned professional schools and companies, in order to broaden the students' international horizon and deepen their understanding and exploration.

2025-2026 Asian Elite Dance Competition

After the different regional competitions during 2024-2025, the Annual Season Final Competition was completed with tremendous success in Shanghai, China in July 2025. Many Mainland China and overseas Ballet authorities have been invited to be AEDC Final's honorable adjudicators. AEDC Final also presents scholarships from worldrenowned ballet schools and companies, such as American Ballet Theatre Studio Company, Elmhurst Ballet School in Association with Birmingham Royal Ballet Summer School, Queensland National Ballet School Summer Intensive, Seoul Universal Ballet Company Summer Intensive, USA Florida Next Generation Ballet Summer Intensive, Indonesia Marlupi Dance Academy Short-term Intensive, Singapore Yan Ballet Academy Short-term Intensive, Berlin State Ballet School Intensive and so on.

AEDC, entering its 12th anniversary, has been enforcing its initial endeavor to invite international renowned adjudicators and academies to judge, strengthen the bonding among ballet contestants, professional schools and companies, provide valuable opportunities for potential contestants to study abroad and practice in companies, and most important of all, to provide an exchange platform for contestants to learn and realize their learning on stage.



Qualification to enter 2026 Season Final

- Participants in the AEDC 2025-2026 Regional Competition, the score must be 80 or above.
- Throughout the year 2025-2026 Regional competition, participants who are invited to the Season Final, are allowed to register the Season Final according to the group which they were in the regional competition.

What is Green Card and Privilege

- The Green Card will be awarded as the "Season Final Competition Scholarship" by the AEDC Organizing Committee.
- Contestants in the Ballet category of the Pre-Competitive, Junior, and Senior Groups who have participated in any of the AEDC regional competitions during the current season are eligible. The top 6 winners with an average score of 85 or above will receive a Green Card invitation letter from the judging panel.
- Contestants who are competing in the category above their age will NOT be awarded the Green Card, even if they are placed in the top 6.
- If a contestant participates in two or more regional competitions during the season and competes in two different age categories due to aging up, they can choose to accept only one Green Card for the Season Final. The other Green Card will be forfeited.
- Contestants who wish to compete in two different age groups at the Season Final must compete in the Semi-Final to qualify for the Final in the second age group. The privileges of Green Card holders include a 50% discount on the total registration fee for the Season Final Competition. Green Card holders are also exempt from the Semi-Final and can directly enter the Final competition. (The Semi-Final performance will not be judged or scored.)
- The unit of ensemble with outstanding performance will also have opportunity to receive green cards. Only 50% of the entry fee will be paid.

Competition Items:

- 1. Classical Ballet Solo
- 2. Contemporary Solo
- 3. Modern Jazz / National Dance Solo
- 4. Group: Duet/Trios, Ensemble, Troupe

Rules & Regulations

1. Classical Ballet (BA) Solo

• <u>Pre-Level, Children & Open Group</u> have **only one round of final competition**. <u>Pre-competitive Groups or above</u> have **semi-final & final competition**. Only allowed to dance one variations in semi-final & final round.

- <u>Pre-Level, Children</u> contestants have **NO master class** and **MUST** perform in **ballet soft shoes**. <u>Open Group</u> have **NO master class** either, but they can join in with extra pay. Other Groups (PC, JR & SR group) have included one master class. They may choose to perform either ballet soft shoes or pointe shoes. Pre-Competitive A & B groups are not recommended to perform in pointe shoes, but it is not obligatory. For <u>Professional Junior A. Junior B and Senior</u> category (minimum of 10 hours training weekly, they **MUST** perform with **POINTE SHOES ONLY**.
- For Children, Pre-Competitive A & B contestants, each variation should not exceed 2.5 minutes. For Junior or above contestants, each variation should not exceed 3 minutes. If any participant refuses to comply with the rules, marks may be subject to deduction
- All contestants must first enter their own age group before they can choose to advance to the higher group. Contestants who enter two groups cannot perform the same variation. Using soft shoes and pointe shoes to dance the same piece is also **NOT** acceptable.
- If any participant refuses to comply with the rules, it is subject to deduction of marks. Overtime of competition piece is considered as violation of rules, will lead to deduction of marks. (Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30 seconds will deduct 5 marks.)
- Within the same competition year, contestants who are awarded Top 6 cannot join another regional competition with the same variation.
- Pre-Level group will have designated variations & music, kindly refer the table below & google link. Others groups are free to choose ballet variations.

2. Contemporary (CD) Solo

3. Modern Jazz (MJ) / National Dance (ND) Solo

- · Contestants cannot duplicate entries in the same group, and cannot apply for group exceeding their actual age.
- Each variation should not exceed 3 minutes. If any participant refuses to comply with the rules, it is subject to deduction of marks. Overtime of competition piece is considered as violation of rules, will lead to deduction of marks. (Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30 seconds will deduct 5 marks.)
- Contemporary (CD) includes contemporary, neoclassical, lyrical, modern dance etc.
- Modern Jazz (MJ) is a dynamic and expressive dance style that emerged in the early 20th century. It incorporates elements of traditional jazz, ballet, and modern dance. Modern jazz often features isolations, contractions, and syncopated rhythms, allowing for a wide range of movement expressions.
- National Dance (ND) also known as folk or ethnic dance, represents the traditional dances of a particular country or region. These dances often reflect the cultural heritage, history, and customs of a specific community. Costumes, music, and movements are influenced by the traditions and folklore of the respective nation, making national dances a rich and diverse category within the world of dance.
- The organising committee does not accept any competition piece which may lead to copyright dispute. Contestants should double check if the dance piece is eligible for competition. If there is any copyright disputes arising, the committee will disqualify the contestants without any refund.

4. Group: Duet/ Trios, Ensemble, Troupe

• Duet/ Trois: 2 to 3 participants - Each should not exceed 4 minutes.

• Ensemble : 4 -8 participants - Each should not exceed 5 minutes.

• Troupe : 9- 20 participants - Each should not exceed 5 minutes.

(Overtime of competition piece is considered as violation of rules, will lead to deduction of marks. Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30 seconds will deduct 5 marks.)

• Group Dance category is determined by the age of the eldest contestant in the group.

1) Registration Fee

- · All Classical Ballet Solo participants in Pre-Competitive, Junior & Senior group are compulsory to attend master class.
- All ballet female solo participants (except Pre Level, Children and Open group) will receive a leotard to attend master class.
- All solo participants will receive a souvenir, medal, E-certificate.
- For group category, each participant will receive a medal and E-certificate and school will receive a trophy and E-certificate.
- Videos & photos can be purchased at <u>RM200.00</u> and submit payment during registration. Otherwise additional fee of <u>RM50.00</u> will be charged for <u>each purchase on/after 3 March, 2026.</u> <u>Videos & photos link will be sent out about 1-2 months after the competition ends.</u>

- Female contestants MUST wear the leotard provided by the association and pink tight
- Male contestants MUST wear white leotard and black tight

We suggest all contestants bring along USB music on the day of the competition for back up. Any late submission of music will be entitled to <u>RM150.00</u> administration fee. Any amendment after application deadline will be charged <u>RM150.00 for each</u> amendment and no amendment is allowed after 03March,2026.

1) Copyright

Once registered in the competition, the contestants agree that the organising committee owns the copyright for all the photos and videos
taken during the competition. Committee can use the photos and videos for promotion purposes, the contestants have no objection to that.

2) Scoring System Allocation

- Classical Ballet Solo, Contemporary Solo and Group (Pre-Competitive, Junior, Senior & Professional Group) are placing from Top 1st to 24th.
- If there are more than 6 contestants who scored ≥ 85 points (percentage system), the jury has not proposed that a certain award should be vacant, the awards will be allocated in order of high scores.
- If less than 3 people in the category group, gold medal will not be given out. Unless his/her performance is very outstanding and got average score is higher than 95 points, and the jury unanimously requests it, he/she will receive a special gold medal.

3) Decision

Asian Elite Dance Competition has the right to all final decisions of the rules and regulations, and the results of competition. Decision of
Jury on distribution of any award, medal, scholarship and prize is final and irrevocable. AEDC Jury reserves the right not to offer any
published award, medal, scholarship or prize if no suitable candidate is identified.

4) Others

- Expenses to attend the competition (e.g. Visa application fee, hotel and meals etc) and insurance against accidents, injury, illness and theft, are at participants' own cost and responsibility.
- Once enrolled in the competition, all contestants agree that the organising committee will not be liable for any injury and accident before and during the competition, including sickness which cause the contestant's withdrawal from the competition. The organising committee is not responsible for that. The contestants should be held accountable for their own health condition and agree to take the responsibility of the competition risks, and cannot request for refund.
