Competition Introduction:

1. Asian Elite Dance Competition

Asian Elite Dance Competition, as an international dance platform, aims to promote ballet art education and to nurture the potential talents around the world. Thus, the competition offers scholarships to outstanding contestants to help them move onto bigger stage ahead. AEDC, since its establishment, does not only promote the exchange among different countries and different ballet disciplines, but also further accelerates the development of ballet art. Contestants' age range has expanded and AEDC now includes different dance disciplines, including classical ballet, contemporary ballet, contemporary, jazz and ensembles and so on.

2022-2023 Asian Elite Dance Competition Season Final

If you want to join the AEDC Season Final and get into the Final round to be awarded, there are two ways:

- 1. Contestant who has joined any of the AEDC regional competitions during 2022-2023 and has been awarded Top 6, or outstanding ensemble groups, should have received Green Card Invitation letter from the judge panels. Green card holder does not need to compete in the Semi-Final and can directly enter the Final around of the competition. All green card holders (soloists or ensemble groups) have been awarded the "Season Final Competition Scholarship" by the AEDC organizing committee.
- 2. Contestant who has not joined any of the AEDC regional competitions during 2022-2023 nor has been awarded Top 6, they have to compete in the Semi-Final round in Yangzhou for the Final round qualification.

2. Competition Categories and Regulations

2.1 Classical Ballet Solo

- All local and overseas contestants are welcome to join.
- Contestants aged 12 or below, regardless of professional or amateur, all compete in the same age-defined group. But for contestants in Junior group or above, all contestants who study in or graduate from professional dance school (regardless of major stream) will be assigned to professional group (i.e. Junior Professional Group and Senior Professional Group).
- Non-professional contestants can choose to compete in same age-defined professional group while professional contestants cannot compete in non-professional group. Contestants entering two groups cannot chose the same variation to compete.
- Each contestant can only enter once in each age group. All contestants must first enter their own age group before they can choose to advance to the higher group. (except for Youth and Adult Group) Contestants who enter two groups cannot perform the same variation. Using soft shoes and pointe shoes to dance the same piece is also not acceptable.

- Contestants who won Top 6 in the previous regionals cannot participate in other upcoming regionals using the same variation. Contestants who won Top 6 in previous Season Final cannot participate in the upcoming Season Final with the same variation, unless progressing to dance in pointe shoes.
- For Children, Pre Competitive A & B contestants, each variation should not exceed 2.5 minutes.
 For Junior & Senior & Youth & Adult contestants, each variation should not exceed 3 minutes.
 Marks will be deducted for exceeding the time limit. (Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30 seconds will deduct 5 marks.)
- Pre-level and Children Group contestants must perform in ballet soft soles; Pre-Competitive A & B groups contestants are not recommended to perform in pointe shoes, but it is not obligatory. Junior group or above may choose to perform in ballet soft shoes or pointe shoes.

2.2 Contemporary Solo

- · All local and overseas contestants, professional or non-professional are all welcome to join.
- The age categories are Pre-competitive (aged 7-10), Junior (aged 11-15) and Senior (aged 16 or above).
- Each contestant can only enter once in each age group and cannot advance into high age group.
- Contemporary contestants, regardless of professional or not, will all compete in the same agedefined group.
- Contemporary dance should not exceed 3 minutes. Marks will be deducted for exceeding the time limit. (Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30 seconds will deduct 5 marks.)
- Contemporary solo includes contemporary dance, modern dance and modern ballet and so on.
- AEDC will not accept entry of any dance which may incur copyright dispute. The contestants
 have the responsibility to ensure that the dance is suitable for participating in competition and live
 broadcast of the competition. AEDC organizing committee has the right to disqualify any dance
 with doubtful copyright, and no refund application will be accepted

2.3 Ensemble

Classical Ballet Ensemble

A. Duet/ Trois: 2 to 3 people

Each Group Dance should not exceed 4 minutes. (Overtime of competition piece is considered as violation of rules, will lead to deduction of marks. Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30 seconds will deduct 5 marks)

B. Large Ensemble: 4-20 people

Each Group Dance should not exceed 5 minutes. (Overtime of competition piece is considered as violation of rules, will lead to deduction of marks. Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30 seconds will deduct 5 marks.)

Contemporary Ensemble

A. Duet/ Trois: 2 to 3 people

Each Group Dance should not exceed 4 minutes. (Overtime of competition piece is considered as violation of rules, will lead to deduction of marks. Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30 seconds will deduct 5 marks)

B. Large Ensemble: 4-20 people

Each Group Dance should not exceed 5 minutes. (Overtime of competition piece is considered as violation of rules, will lead to deduction of marks. Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30 seconds will deduct 5 marks.)

Ensemble Group Dance category is determined by the age of the eldest contestant in the dance piece.

Important Note:

- AEDC will not accept entry of any dance which may incur copyright dispute. The contestants
 have the responsibility to ensure that the dance is suitable for participating in competition and live
 broadcast of the competition. AEDC organizing committee has the right to disqualify any dance
 with doubtful copyright, and no refund application will be accepted.
- All ensemble certificates, prize medal/ trophy will be awarded in the name of the participating organization. If any contestant in the ensemble wants to apply for personal certificate, please contact the organizing committee.

2.4 Green Card Holders

- All soloists who have obtained Green Card from AEDC regional competitions only need to compete in the Final round of the Season Final. They do not need to compete in the Semi-Final round.
- Green Card Soloists directly enter the Final round of the Season Final, but they can still attend master class with all other non- green card contestants.
- If contestants have ever participated in higher group than their own age-defined group and have been awarded Top 6 in both groups, they will not obtain Green Card of the higher group.

For instance: A contestant aged 12 applied in both PC-B and Junior Group, her outstanding performance awarded her Top 6 in both groups. This contestant will only be offered Green Card of PC-B Group, but not Junior Group.

If contestants have ever participated in two or more regional competitions and due to the increase in age, they join two different age groups respectively. They get green card from both groups. They have to decide which green card they will use for the Season Final beforehand. The other green card will be forfeited. If they want to compete in the other groups, they have to compete in semi-final in order to get the qualification to enter Final.

For instance: During 2020-2021, a contestant has participated in two AEDC regional competitions. She joined the PC-A Group for the first time as she is 10 years old. She then joined the PC-B Group for the second time as she turns 11 years old. She obtained Green Card for both groups. However, in Season Final, she can only choose to use either PC-A or PC-B green card. After making the decision, the other green card will be forfeited. If she chooses to use the PC-A Green Card and also want to compete in PC-B, she has to compete in the semi-final of PC-B group in order to get the qualification to enter Final.

Any contestants who want to compete in higher age group, due to the increasing age, have to first forgo the Green Card they obtained initially. They have to compete in the Semi-Final of Season Final in order to get qualified into the Final round.

For instance: A contestant aged 12 obtained Green Card of PC-B Group in the regional competition during the year. She turns 13 at the time of Season Final, she can still compete in PC-B Group. However, if she wants to compete in Junior Group, she has to first forgo the Green Card of PC-B. She then competes in Junior Group Semi-Final with all other non-Green Card holders to fight for the Final round qualification.

■ All Green Card holders (soloists or ensemble groups) will be offered "2022-2023 Season Final Competition Scholarship". The Green Card soloists will only have to pay 50% of the total application fee of the competition. (i.e. Semi-Final + Final application fee 50%) Green Card Ensemble Group will only need to pay 50% of the Final application fee.

3. Competition Groups

Solo

3.1 Classical Ballet Solo -Pre-level group

- Pre-level group is for contestants aged 5-6.
- All pre-level contestants must perform designated variations by the committee, contestants and teachers can click the following link to download the designated variation's video and music. If non-designated variation is chosen for competition, 5 marks will be deducted from the overall score.
- All pre-level contestants must choose from the designated variations list to perform in competition. The organizing committee accept minor changes to the steps of the dance, taken into consideration of the contestants' technique level and safety concern. The committee advises not to alter the dance to a difficult technique level which is beyond the contestants' age and technique ability. The judges may impose penalty on dance which is unacceptably difficult for the contestants and the jury's decision is final.
- After receiving the applications, the organizing committee will standardize the variation's music
 (for Pre-level Group only). The committee does not accept any alteration to the variation music.
 Please use the committee's assigned music for practice, it is not necessary to prepare your own music.
- All contestants have to prepare their own props and check the safety before the competition.

- The organizing committee is not responsible for any injury or accident before and during competition, (including but not limited to accidents caused by props or technical steps arrangement, sickness etc.) The contestants are fully responsible for their own health and safety.
- All pre-level demonstration videos are owned by Hong Kong Youth Dance Association, only for contestants for learning the competition designated variation. If other unauthorized use is found, the organizing committee reserve the right of prosecution.

3.2 Classical Ballet Solo - Children group

- Children group is for contestants aged 7-8.
- Contestants in Children group can attend ONE master class in the Season Final this
 year. They have to compete in the semi-final of the Season Final before they are
 qualified into the Final round.
- For Children group contestants, each variation should not exceed 2.5 minutes. Marks will be deducted for exceeding the time limit. (Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30 seconds will deduct 5 marks.) Contestants must wear soft shoes to compete.

3.3 Classical Ballet Solo - Pre-competitive A group

- Pre-competitive A group is for contestants aged 9-10.
- Contestants in Pre-competitive A group can attend ONE master class in the Season Final this
 year. They have to compete in the semi-final of the Season Final before they are qualified into the
 Final round if they do not obtain Green Card in the regionals.
- For Pre-competitive A group contestants, each variation should not exceed 2.5 minutes. Marks
 will be deducted for exceeding the time limit. (Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and
 exceeding 30 seconds will deduct 5 marks.) Contestants are not recommended to wear pointe
 shoes to compete, but it is not obligatory.
- Contestants under 12, no matter they are professional or not, are all competing in the same agedefined group.

3.4 Classical Ballet Solo - Pre-competitive B group

- Pre-competitive B group is for contestants aged 11-12.
- Contestants in Pre-competitive B Group can attend **TWO** master classes in the Season Final this year. They have to compete in the semi-final of the Season Final before they are qualified into the Final round if they do not obtain Green Card in the regionals.
- For Pre-competitive B group contestants, each variation should not exceed 2.5 minutes. Marks
 will be deducted for exceeding the time limit. (Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and
 exceeding 30 seconds will deduct 5 marks.) Contestants are not recommended to wear pointe
 shoes to compete, but it is not obligatory.
- Contestants under 12, no matter they are professional or not, are all competing in the same agedefined group.

3.5 Classical Ballet Solo - Junior A/ Professional Junior A group

- Junior A/ Professional Junior A group is for contestants aged 13-14.
- Contestants in Junior A/ Professional Junior A Group can attend TWO master classes in the Season Final this year. They have to compete in the semi-final of the Season Final before they are qualified into the Final round if they do not obtain Green Card in the regionals.

- For Junior A/ Professional Junior A group contestants, each variation should not exceed 3 minutes. Marks will be deducted for exceeding the time limit. (Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30 seconds will deduct 5 marks.) Contestants can choose whether to wear pointe shoes to compete, but it is not obligatory.
- Contestants aged 13 or above who study in or graduated from professional dance school (regardless of major stream) will be assigned to professional group. Contestants have to declare clearly as the truth.

3.6 Classical Ballet Solo – Junior B/ Professional Junior B group

- Junior B/ Professional Junior B group is for contestants aged 15-16.
- Contestants in Junior B / Professional Junior B group can attend TWO master classes in the Season Final this yea. They have to compete in the semi-final of the Season Final before they are qualified into the Final round if they do not obtain Green Card in the regionals.
- For Junior B/ Professional Junior B group contestants, each variation should not exceed 3 minutes. Marks
 will be deducted for exceeding the time limit. (Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30
 seconds will deduct 5 marks.) Contestants can choose whether to wear pointe shoes to compete, but it is
 not obligatory.
- Contestants aged 13 or above who study in or graduated from professional dance school (regardless of major stream) will be assigned to professional group. Contestants have to declare clearly as the truth.

3.7 Classical Ballet Solo - Senior/ Professional Senior group

- Senior/ Professional Senior group is for contestants aged 17-21.
- Contestants in Senior/ Professional Senior Group can attend TWO master classes in the Season Final this year. They have to compete in the semi-final of the Season Final before they are qualified into the Final round if they do not obtain Green Card in the regionals.
- For Senior/ Professional Senior group contestants, each variation should not exceed 3 minutes. Marks will
 be deducted for exceeding the time limit. (Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30
 seconds will deduct 5 marks.) Contestants can choose whether to wear pointe shoes to compete, but it is
 not obligatory.
- Contestants aged 13 or above who study in or graduated from professional dance school (regardless of major stream) will be assigned to professional group. Contestants have to declare clearly as the truth.

Note: Contestants aged 21 or below cannot join the Youth or Adult Group.

3.8 Classical Ballet Solo – Youth / Professional Youth group

- Youth/ Professional Youth group is for contestants aged 22-27.
- Contestants in Youth/ Professional Youth Group can attend TWO master classes in the Season Final this year. They have to compete in the semi-final of the Season Final before they are qualified into the Final round if they do not obtain Green Card in the regionals.
- For Youth/ Professional Youth group contestants, each variation should not exceed 3 minutes. Marks will be
 deducted for exceeding the time limit. (Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30 seconds
 will deduct 5 marks.) Contestants can choose whether to wear pointe shoes to compete, but it is not
 obligatory.
- Contestants aged 13 or above who study in or graduated from professional dance school (regardless of major stream) will be assigned to professional group. Contestants have to declare clearly as the truth.

Note: Contestants aged 27 or below cannot join the Adult group, however, amateur contestants aged 21 or above can join the Senior group and amateur contestants aged 28 or above can join the Youth group.

3.9 Classical Ballet Solo – Adult / Professional Adult group

- Adult/ Professional Adult group is for contestants aged 28 or above.
- Contestants in Adult/ Professional Adult group can attend TWO master classes in the Season Final this year. They have to compete in the semi-final of the Season Final before they are qualified into the Final round if they do not obtain Green Card in the regionals.
- For Adult/ Professional Adult group contestants, each variation should not exceed 3 minutes. Marks will be
 deducted for exceeding the time limit. (Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30 seconds
 will deduct 5 marks.) Contestants can choose whether to wear pointe shoes to compete, but it is not
 obligatory.
- Contestants aged 13 or above who study in or graduated from professional dance school (regardless of major stream) will be assigned to professional group. Contestants have to declare clearly as the truth.

Note: Contestants aged 27 or below cannot join the Adult group, however, amateur contestants aged 21 or above can join the Senior group and amateur contestants aged 28 or above can join the Youth group.

3.10 Contemporary Solo- Pre-competitive/ Junior/ Senior

- The age categories are Pre-competitive (aged 7-10), Junior (aged 11-15) and Senior (aged 16 or above).
- Each contestant can only enter once in each age group and cannot advance into high age group.
- Contemporary contestants, regardless of professional or not, will all compete in the same age-defined group.
- Contemporary dance should not exceed 3 minutes. Marks will be deducted for exceeding the time limit. (Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30 seconds will deduct 5 marks.)
- Contemporary solo includes contemporary dance, modern dance and modern ballet and so on.

Note: AEDC will not accept entry of any dance which may incur copyright dispute. The contestants have the responsibility to ensure that the dance is suitable for participating in competition and live broadcast of the competition. Ensemble

3.11 Ballet Duet/Trois -Pre-competitive/ Junior/ Senior

- Duet/Trois- 2-3 people. The age categories are Pre-competitive (aged 6-10), Junior (aged 11-15) and Senior (aged 16 or above). Ensemble category is determined by the age of the eldest contestant in the group dance.
- Duet/ Trois dance should not exceed 4 minutes. Marks will be deducted for exceeding the time limit. (Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30 seconds will deduct 5 marks.)

3.12 Ballet Ensemble -Pre-competitive/ Junior/ Senior

- Ensemble- 4-20 people. The age categories are Pre-competitive (aged 6-10), Junior (aged 11-15) and Senior (aged 16 or above). Ensemble category is determined by the age of the eldest contestant in the group dance.
- Ensemble dance should not exceed 5 minutes. Marks will be deducted for exceeding the time limit. (Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30 seconds will deduct 5 marks.)

3.13 Contemporary Duet/Trois -Pre-competitive/ Junior/ Senior

- Duet/Trois-2-3 people. The age categories are Pre-competitive (aged 7-10), Junior (aged 11-15) and Senior (aged 16 or above). Ensemble category is determined by the age of the eldest contestant in the group dance.
- Duet/ Trios dance should not exceed 4 minutes. Marks will be deducted for exceeding the time limit. (Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30 seconds will deduct 5 marks.)

3.14 Contemporary Ensemble -Pre-competitive/ Junior/ Senior

- Ensemble- 4-20 people. The age categories are Pre-competitive (aged 7-10), Junior (aged 11-15) and Senior (aged 16 or above). Ensemble category is determined by the age of the eldest contestant in the group dance.
- Ensemble dance should not exceed 5 minutes. Marks will be deducted for exceeding the time limit. (Exceeding 15 seconds will deduct 1 mark and exceeding 30 seconds will deduct 5 marks.)

Copyright

Decision

Asian Elite Dance Competition has the right to all final decisions of the rules and regulations, and the results of competition. Decision of Jury on distribution of any award, medal, scholarship and prize is final and irrevocable. AEDC Jury reserves the right not to offer any published award, medal, scholarship or prize if no suitable candidate is identified.

Documents Required

The registration form of solo dance should be uploaded online, including the ID photo, electronic scan of ID card/passport and the home page and personal page of the household register (must be uploaded by contestants from mainland China).

The registration form of Ensemble should be uploaded with the electronic scanning version of ID card/passport online(the remaining scanning copies of more than 15 people will be uploaded by the staff of the organizing Committee after the successful registration, if any queries may contact us).

All contestants have to provide their ID or passports during registration on competition days.

Contestants Under 18 Notice

For the contestants under 18, their parents or guardians have to sign the consent form for performance and competition.
